Mooring Rates * Non-Transient Vessels (monthly mooring) = \$5.00 per foot year round
Transient Vessels = \$20.00 per day year round

(Note: per Municipal Code Section 13.24.070(2), a transient vessel may be used as a residence for not more than three consecutive days in any fourteen day period. Vessel owner is responsible to notify the City upon departure in order to stop billing of monthly mooring fees). All fees are to be paid by personal check or money order, payable to the City of Petaluma. **DO NOT SEND CASH through the mail.** Payment can be mailed to: City of Petaluma, Finance Department, Attn: Isabel Craft, P.O. Box 61, Petaluma, CA 94953. Check or cash can be dropped off at City hall, 11 English Street, Finance Department, Petaluma, during normal business hours, 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Thursday, or **checks only** may be placed in the drop box located at the Petaluma Yacht Club, next to the rear door of the building, at 10 "C" Street. **Include this form with payment.** Please write on the check the name of the vessel and/or CF number, and date of stay. *** Nonpayment of fee will result in eviction from the Turning Basin at owner's expense.**
