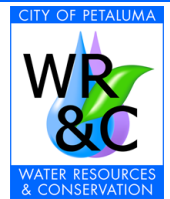


'C' Street Pump Station Upgrade

Project Description

Project Number C00500205

This project will make structural, mechanical, and electrical improvements to meet existing flow capacity, reliability, safety and maintenance requirements and reduce the likelihood of damage from flooding during winter storms to the existing wastewater pump station built in 1968.

Improvements include:

Demolition of structural concrete, removal and replacement of existing mechanical and electrical systems, standby generator, by-pass pumping during construction and architectural improvements including horizontal siding and new roofing. The project also includes sidewalk and site improvements.
