Meeting was called to order at 6:10 by Chair Lofroos.

**ROLL CALL:** Present: Arras, Asselmeier, Hatheway, Hauswald, Lofroos\*, Webster, Yetter

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Minutes of June 11, 2008, were approved.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** The Committee will hear public comments only on matters over which it has jurisdiction. There will be no Committee discussion or action. The Chair will allot no more than five minutes to any individual. If more than three persons wish to speak, their time will be allotted so that the total amount of time allocated to this agenda item will be 15 minutes.

**COMMITTEE BUSINESS:** Chair Lofroos was re-elected Committee Chair and Committee Member Webster was chosen as Vice Chair. Committee Member Yetter was interested in the position of Vice Chair but is unable to serve at this time. Committee Member Webster has agreed to serve until such time as Committee Member Yetter is able. It was agreed that minute taking would rotate through the membership.

**OLD BUSINESS:** Chair Lofroos and Committee Member Yetter gave a short report on the planned presentation to the Lucchesi Kids Summer Camp. As to the possible Newspaper Editorial: the suggestion was made that individual letters might be a better and more efficient plan – there was agreement but no vote on this idea.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Petaluma Pro-Wash removed at request of applicant.

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA:** Next Meeting will be August 13, 2008

**COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

Planning Commission (Arras) - There are new commission members but no plans to review.

Petaluma Development Code Committee - Committee Member Asselmeier made a report.

Sonoma County Bicycle Coalition (Album) - Bernie Album reported that the County is not receiving its fair share of Measure M monies, and is preparing a legal case to claim the funds.

Public Works - Frank Penry informed the Committee of a new state law (AB 343) that states that all documents that are shared at a Committee meeting must be submitted to the City Clerk so as to be included in the public record. Frank Penry to check to see if that is documents only submitted by Committee Members, or also including information brought by a member of the public. Also, the Committee looked at the D Street Bridge Closure alternate bicycle route which is identical to the previous D Street Bridge Closure alternate bicycle route.
