## City of Petaluma Development Code Advisory Committee

August 13, 2007

The City of Petaluma is beginning the process of updating its zoning, subdivision and related use and development regulations into a comprehensive Development Code. To assist City staff and consultants in the preparation of the new Development Code, the City Council has authorized the creation of a "Development Code Advisory Committee" comprised of members of the City Council (the Committee Co-Chairs will be Councilmembers Teresa Barrett and David Rabbitt), Planning Commission, Site Plan and Architectural Review Committee (SPARC) and the Historic and Cultural Preservation Committee (also known as Historic SPARC), as well as members of the community representing one or more of the following local interests and professions:

- Real Estate/Commercial Leasing
- Civil Engineer/Land Surveyor
- Local Business Owner
- Local Contractor
- Chamber of Commerce
- Home Builders Association
- Architect
- Community/Neighborhood Group
- Environmental Group
- Green Building
- Central Petaluma Specific Plan Citizens Advisory Committee

The primary role of the Development Code Advisory Committee will be to provide guidance and technical assistance to City staff and consultants preparing the new code. Typical responsibilities will include attendance at regular Committee meetings, discuss and provide direction on specific code related issues as they arise, and make recommendations on code related content and format.

The letter should not only express your interest in serving on the committee, but also describe how your background and experience represents one or more of the identified interest groups or professions. The City Council will select the Development Code Advisory Committee at the 7:00 PM session of its regular meeting of **Monday, September 10, 2007**.

Dates and times and the location of the Development Code Advisory Committee meetings will be determined by the consensus of the membership after the committee is appointed. Meetings will be at least once a month and may be more frequent over the course of the Development Code revision process depending on circumstances. Meetings will probably last up to 2 hours.
