NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to City Council Resolution No. 2008-189 N.C.S., *Establishing a Policy and Procedure for the Preparation, Review and Use of Fiscal and Economic Impact Assessment for Specified Development Projects in the City of Petaluma*, an Fiscal and Economic Impact Assessment has been completed for the proposed Deer Creek Village project to be located at the southwest corner of the intersection of Rainier Avenue and McDowell Boulevard, adjacent to Highway 101.


Merlone Geier Partners is proposing a 315,000 square foot mixed-use development on approximately 36 acres with 1,322 parking spaces. Uses include a home improvement center, a fitness center, restaurants, pharmacy, retail stores and medical office space.

CITY COUNCIL MEETING DATE/TIME: Monday, May 4, 2009 at or after 7:00 p.m.

LOCATION: City Council Chambers, Petaluma City Hall, 11 English Street, Petaluma, CA 94952.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN: As required by the resolution, the City Council will hold a public hearing to consider and discuss the FEIA and the project, and to permit project applicants, FEIA consultants, and the public to comment on the FEIA and the project. The hearing is required prior to the granting of any land use entitlements; no action will be taken.

If you challenge in court the matter described above, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered at, or prior to, the above-referenced public hearing. {Government Code Section 65009(b)(2)}. Judicial review of an administrative decision of the City Council must be filed with the Court not later than the 90th day following the date of the Council's decision. (Code of Civil Procedure Section 1094.6)
