

DOG RUN AREAS

In all dog run areas four rules apply.

A responsible person must:

- Stay in the area with the animal.
- Keep the animal under voice control.
- Observe the anti-litter law by cleaning up after the dog.
- Take no more than three (3) dogs in the dog run area.

DOG PARK ETIQUETTE

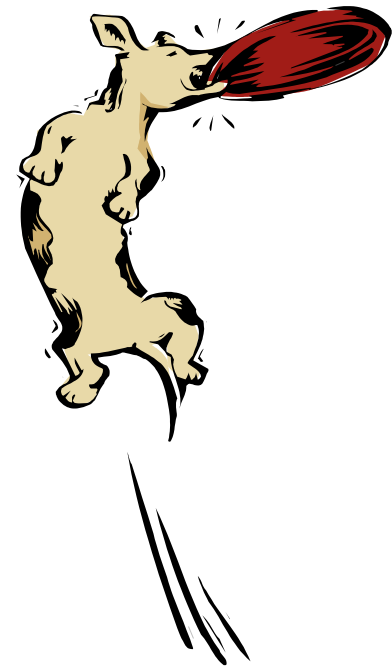
1. Only let your dog run free in designated areas and at designated times.
2. Be courteous to other park users.
 - Ask before letting your dog greet another dog or person. Don't let your dog chase joggers, bikers, or cars.
3. Pick up after your dog!
 - Always carry a plastic bag and watch your dog.
4. Monitor your dog's play.
 - Mounting should be interrupted. It's rude. If your dog's play partner looks scared or irritated, remove your dog for a moment.
5. Leave training collars at home.
 - Many dogs suffer broken teeth, broken jaws, and have even been strangled when playmates get their jaws caught in a pinch, choke, or slip collar.
6. Think twice about bringing toys if your dog is at all possessive of them.
7. Leave small children at home or keep them in your arms or stroller at all times.
8. Let your veterinarian know your dog goes to dog parks.
 - Do not take your puppy to the dog park or any other public area until his/her initial vaccination series is complete.
9. Have your dog spayed or neutered.
10. Does your dog always come when called?
 - If not, then you don't have control. Consider enrolling your dog in a family dog training or puppy classes to get you and your pup on the right track.
